



### **CANTERBURY EARTHQUAKE (CANTERBURY DISTRICT HEALTH BOARD LAND EXCHANGE) ORDER 2014**

1. On 16 January 2014 the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Review Panel (the Review Panel) considered the Canterbury Earthquake (Canterbury District Health Board Land Exchange) Order 2014.
2. The Review Panel considered the letter from Michael Hundleby, Acting National Director, National Health Board.
3. The Review Panel noted that the process followed by officials is robust, extensive consultation has been held, and amendments have been made as a result. The parties holding significant interests and rights in these areas all support the proposal. The draft Order is in the best interests of Christchurch city and its wider community.
4. The Review Panel is of the view that the draft Order is necessary and meets the purposes of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

**Recommendation**

1. The Review Panel recommends to the Minister for Health that the Canterbury Earthquake (Canterbury District Health Board Land Exchange) Order 2014 be made without change.
