First Winter Chill events announced

Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Authority Chief Executive Roger Sutton says it's exciting to see so many young people and youth organisations wanting to get involved in putting on great events through the Winter Chill event series.

The first round of events from the series, announced today, range from music gigs to sports activities to events in the creative space, all aimed at and planned or produced by people between the ages of 12 and 24.

Winter Chill is a series of fun and exciting youth-led events and activities for young people. It has been developed in response to findings from the 2013 Youth Wellbeing Survey which highlighted the need for safe and enjoyable places to go and things to do.

"Young people and youth organisations have really stepped up to make the most of the opportunity this funding offers. The variety of applications show there's a lot of diverse groups in the city keen to make it a better place for young people," says Mr Sutton.

"Some of that's been in a small way, like funding a venue for a junior rugby prize giving. On the bigger end of things, the fund is helping provide heavily subsidised youth tickets for TEDxChristchurch."

"Big or small, the events all have one thing in common: they're filling a need for young people to have fun stuff to do in greater Christchurch."

It's a need the series is meeting fast, with the majority of the \$150,000 fund already allocated.

"Young people have been quick to respond, but applications are still open, and we're approving more every day. We're really excited to see what other ideas the city's young people come up with for the rest of the fund," says Mr Sutton.

Events coming up in the next few weeks include Thomas Reveley's exhibition The Tree Felled in Winter; In Spring the Sap Rising at Room Four, the Steampunk Fashion Runway at Christchurch South Library, Rowley's Got Talent at Rowley School and an under 18 concert featuring Broods at the Bedford.

The funding has been made available by Fletcher Building and the Ministry of Youth Development's Canterbury Youth Initiatives Fund.
